

Greifswalder Ukrainicum

August 11–25, 2010

From August 11–25, the fifteenth „Greifswalder Ukrainicum“ takes place at the Alfried Krupp Institute of Advanced Study in Greifswald/Germany. The scientific chair of this International Summer Academy for the science and culture of Ukraine is Professor Dr. Alexander Wöll (University of Greifswald).

Participation

The participation at Ukrainicum is open for everybody interested in the Science of Ukraine. Knowledge of Ukrainian is not required. The number of participants is limited to 75 persons.

Participation fee

150 € regular fee

100 € student fee (please provide your student ID or equivalent at the beginning of Ukrainicum)

The participation fee includes registration, course material, seminar drinks and the participation at the scientific and cultural program of the summer school as well as the excursion.

Course and content of the scientific program

Until midday, four language courses at different levels (Beginner without knowledge of cyrillic letters, beginners with knowledge of cyrillic letters, Intermediate, Advanced) offer the opportunity to learn Ukrainian or improve existent skills.

Language course instructors:

Vira Makovska (Greifswald) – beginner level with knowledge of cyrillic letters

Anna Olshevska (Bochum) – beginner level without knowledge of cyrillic letters

After midday, three seminars are offered:

Seminar 1:

Feminismus und Frauenliteratur in der Ukraine

Scientific instructor: Professor Dr. Alfred Sproede (Münster)

Language: German

Seminar 2:

Ukraine–Russia: A historical perspective on contemporary relations

Scientific instructor: Professor Dr. Guido Hausmann (Freiburg)

Language: English

Seminar 3:

Українська література: Виклики глобалізації

Scientific instructor: Professor Dr. Vitaly Chernetsky (Miami University, Ohio)

Language: Ukrainian

Please indicate the choice of your courses and seminars along with your registration. We kindly ask all Ukrainicum participants to choose a language course according to their own estimation. After the first class, a final division into the courses is made. It is possible to attend both the German and the English seminar, as they are held one after another.

For the courses and seminars, the Institute provides course material (reader), available for download 6 weeks in advance of the summer school. Language courses and seminars take place daily from August 12–25 (note that this is Thursday till Wednesday) except for both Sundays. If desired, the library of the Slavonic institute can be used to a limited extend.

Exams

It is possible to pass an exam at the end of both language courses and seminars. The exams are assigned for all courses on the last day of Ukrainicum (Wednesday, August 25); participants who do not want to pass an exam, can take part in the regular courses.

The participation at both the language courses and the seminars can be issued with a certificate by the Alfried Krupp Institute of Advanced Study. The home university decides about acknowledging these courses as a course achievement; we recommend an early clarification with your home university. Please indicate with your registration if you would like to pass an exam, so that the seminar instructors can be informed beforehand.

Cultural program

The participant's fee includes the whole cultural and social program of Ukrainicum as well as the excursion. The excursion is a bus tour to the Isle of Rügen; please bring sturdy footwear for the sightseeing of the Prora Memorial and swimming equipment for the second part of the day at the Baltic Sea shore with you.

At August 22, a cultural training in preparation for a possible study stay in Ukraine is offered. This training concept is catered to German-speaking participants and works with the stereotypes of Germans and Ukrainians. Therefore, only German native speakers can take part in this training. We thank you for your understanding. The number of participants is limited to 15.

Accommodation

In order to offer a cheap accommodation for as many Ukrainicum participants as possible, the Ukrainicum cooperates with both academic and private dormitories. Accordingly, different rooms and conditions are available. These rooms are temporarily unrented, so please don't expect a fully equipped guestroom.

The prices stated below concern the whole Ukrainicum (arrival at August 10, departure at August 26). All rooms are equipped with bedding and a small tableware set (dish, soup bowl, cup, cutlery); Internet is available in all rooms for free.

Accommodation in student dormitories

Dormitory ‚Geschwister-Scholl-Straße 11‘

Bed in double room: 145,00 € (10 beds)

Double rooms for two people. The rooms are shared by participants of the same sex only; bathrooms are shared by either one or two accommodation units. Common kitchens and Internet are available. Cooking pot and pan are provided; not included are towels, cleaning equipment and an ethernet cable.

Dormitory ‚Makarenkostraße 47‘

Single room : 175,00 € (11 rooms)

Single rooms with common baths and kitchens. Cooking pot and pan are provided; not included are towels, cleaning equipment and an ethernet cable. Please note that this dormitory is unrenovated and less comfortable!

Dormitory ‚Makarenkostraße 48-51‘

Single room in double apartment: 192,00 € (5 rooms for men, 9 rooms for women)

Single room in an apartment for two persons, bathroom and kitchen used together. The second person is not a participant of Ukrainicum. The rooms are given to persons of the same sex as the second lodger. Towels included, please bring cooking equipment with you. Not included are cleaning equipment and an ethernet cable.

Dormitory ‚Makarenkostraße 48-51‘

Single room in a flat community: 192,00 € (5 rooms, one for men only, one for women only)

Single room in a flat community, common baths and kitchens. Towels included, please bring cooking equipment with you. Not included are cleaning equipment and an ethernet cable.

Payment of the participation fee, Cancellation, Waitlist

It is possible to name a substitute at any time. In case of a full cancellation, we try to give these places to other people interested in Ukrainicum through clearing.

Until August 1, cancellation is free. A later cancellation can be charged. The participation fee is reimbursed in full.
